

6. Client has full printing rights of original, edited, high resolution jpeg photos provided by Shannon A. Photography. Shannon A. Photography is not responsible for third party printing inconsistencies that may alter the appearance of photos such as discoloration or cropping.

7. Client grants Shannon A. Photography permission to display selected images resulting from this assignment as an example of photographer's work and for entrance into photographic competitions and releases all claims to profits that may arise from use of images.

8. Limit of liability: In the unlikely event that all the originals are lost, stolen, damaged, or destroyed within or beyond Shannon A. Photography's control, Photographer's liability is limited to the refund of all payments received, or a reshoot can be scheduled at no additional cost. The limit of liability for partial loss or damage of originals shall be a prorated amount of the total amount, based on the percentage of originals lost or damaged. In the unlikely event that Photographer is injured or becomes too ill to attend the portrait session, Photographer will make every effort to reschedule to the earliest possible date.

9. Client agrees to agreed upon scheduled time with Shannon A. Photography. If client does not show up during scheduled time on scheduled date, Photographer is no longer responsible for photographing or delivering photographs.

10. Original photographs are not included, only edits. Photographer retains the right to edit the photographs and omit any image. It is understood that photographer will not deliver every exposure taken. Client agrees to abide by Photographer's editing and photograph selections and decisions.

11. All images posted to social media or other digital outlets must credit Shannon A. Photography. Failure to do so can result in legal action.

12. Photographer will give 2 hours notice via email if date needs to be rescheduled due to weather. Photographer is not responsible if client is unable to attend rain date so should the rain date be enacted due to weather. Client understands that the agreed upon rain date is the new date of scheduled session if this announcement is made. The date is not up for negotiation.

13. Client understands that Photographer may have cords, light stands, and other gear at the location. Client will hold Photographer harmless for any damage, personal injury, or loss caused by tripping over or otherwise being injured from this equipment. Client further agrees to hold Photographer harmless for any personal injury which may occur as the Client poses or works with Photographer.

14. Client understands that original photographs are not included, only edits. Photographer retains the right to edit the photographs and omit any image. It is understood that photographer will not deliver every exposure taken. Client agrees to abide by Photographer's editing and photograph selections and decisions.

15. Client understands that photographer's post-edits will not include major physical or digital alterations except those that the photographer deems artistically necessary.
